## Following Jesus – Come as you are Matthew 11:25-30

What stops people coming to Jesus? Why don't people believe?

## Verses 25-26 – Jesus' prayer of praise

- 1. In v 25-26 Jesus says that the gospel is hidden from the "wise and learned." Why do you think that is? (See also 1 Cor. 1 v 18-30)
- 2. What does it look like to receive the good news like little children?

### Verses 27 – the Son and the Father

- 3. What does v 27 show us about the relationship between Jesus and the Father?
- 4. What qualities does Jesus reveal to us of the character of God?

### Verses 28-30 – Jesus' invitation

- 5. What are some of the things in our lives which make us feel weary and burdened?
- 6. What kind of rest does Jesus give us? When have you experienced that rest?
- 7. The Pharisees spoke of the "yoke of the law." How does this contrast with Jesus' yoke?
- 8. What does it mean to take Jesus' yoke on ourselves and learn from Him?
- 9. This is the only place in the gospels where Jesus describes his heart. What does it mean to be gentle and humble in heart? (See also Phil. 2 v 6-8)

If you feel able to, share what is making you feel weary and burdened and pray for each other.
